Current population demographics and changes in demographic composition over time play a determining role in the types of health and social services needed by communities.


Total Population


Population, Density (Persons per Sq Mile by Tract, ACS 2017-21


























Median Age by Tract, ACS 2017-21








Population Age 0-17, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21










Population Age 18-64, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21
















Disabled Population, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21













Population with Limited English Proficiency, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21













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Non US Citizen Population, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21













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
Median Household Income by Tract, ACS 2017-21







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Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21















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Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21












Enrollment in School, Children (Age 3-4), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21




Attainment - Overview

Percent Population with No High School Diploma





Population with No High School Diploma (Age 25+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21







Population with No High School Diploma (Age 25+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21









Attainment - High School Graduation Rate

The adjusted cohort graduation rate (ACGR) is a graduation metric that follows a "cohort" of first-time 9th graders in a particular school year, and adjust this number by adding any students who transfer into the cohort after 9th grade and subtracting any students who transfer out, emigrate to another country, or pass away. The ACGR is the percentage of the students in this cohort who graduate within four years. In the report area, the adjusted cohort graduation rate was 96.9% during the most recently reported school year. 





Family Households, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21







































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Uninsured Population, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21



















Voter Turnout, Rate by County, Townhall.com 2020





Teen Births, Rate Per 1,000 Females Age 15-19 by County, CDC NVSS 2014-2020





Property Crimes, All, Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, FBI UCR 2014; 2016





Air & Water Quality - Particulate Matter 2.5

This indicator reports the percentage of days with particulate matter 2.5 levels above the National Ambient Air Quality Standard (35 micrograms per cubic meter) per year, calculated using data collected by monitoring stations and modeled to include counties where no monitoring stations occur. This indicator is relevant because poor air quality contributes to respiratory issues and overall poor health.






Fine Particulate Matter Levels (PM 2.5), Percentage of Days Above NAAQ Standards by Tract, NEPHTN 2016




Broadband Access - FABRIC Locations, 25/3+ MBPS, Percent by County, FCC December, 2022














Climate & Health - Drought Severity

Weeks in Drought (Any), Percent




Drought - Weeks in Drought (Any), Percent by Tract, US Drought Monitor 2017-2019







Clinical Care and Prevention

A lack of access to care presents barriers to good health. Supply of facilities and physicians, the rate of uninsurance, financial hardship, transportation barriers, cultural competency, and coverage limitations affect access.

Rates of morbidity, mortality, and emergency hospitalizations can be reduced if community residents access services such as health screenings, routine tests, and vaccinations. Prevention indicators can call attention to a lack of access or knowledge regarding one or more health issues and can inform program interventions.

Cancer Screening - Mammogram (Medicare)

This indicator reports the percentage of female Medicare beneficiaries age 35 and older who had a mammogram in most recent reporting year. The American Cancer Society recommends that women age 45 to 54 should get a mammogram every year, and women age 55 and older should get a mammogram every other year. In the latest reporting period there were 5,440 Medicare beneficiaries in the report area, and 35% of female beneficiaries age 35 or older had a mammogram in the past year. The rate in the report area was higher than the state rate of 29% during the same time period.





Mammogram, Medicare Beneficiaries, Percent of Medicare Beneficiaries by County, CMS 2019



This indicator can also highlight a lack of access to preventive care, a lack of health knowledge, insufficient provider outreach, and/or social barriers preventing utilization of services.

As of year 2019, 287 or 94.41% Medicare enrollees with diabetes have had an annual exam out of 304 Medicare enrollees with diabetes in the report area.



Patients with Annual HA1C Test (Diabetes), Percent of Medicare Enrollees with Diabetes by County, Dartmouth Atlas 2019









Health Behaviors

Health behaviors such as poor diet, a lack of exercise, and substance abuse contribute to poor health status.

Alcohol - Heavy Alcohol Consumption

In the report area, 3,878, or 18.52% adults self-report excessive drinking in the last 30 days, which is greater than the state rate of 16.83%. Data for this indicator were based on survey responses to the 2020 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) annual survey and are used for the 2023 County Health Rankings.

Excessive drinking is defined as the percentage of the population who report at least one binge drinking episode involving five or more drinks for men and four or more for women over the past 30 days, or heavy drinking involving more than two drinks per day for men and more than one per day for women, over the same time period. Alcohol use is a behavioral health issue that is also a risk factor for a number of negative health outcomes, including: physical injuries related to motor vehicle accidents, stroke, chronic diseases such as heart disease and cancer, and mental health conditions such as depression and suicide. There are a number of evidence-based interventions that may reduce excessive/binge drinking; examples include raising taxes on alcoholic beverages, restricting access to alcohol by limiting days and hours of retail sales, and screening and counseling for alcohol abuse (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Preventing Excessive Alcohol Use, 2020).

Excessive Drinking, Percent of Adults Age 18+ by County, CDC BRFSS 2020













Chlamydia, Infection Rate per 100,000 Population by County, CDC



















Health Outcomes

Measuring morbidity and mortality rates allows assessing linkages between social determinants of health and outcomes. 





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
Beneficiaries with Asthma, Percent by County, CMS 2018







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Beneficiaries with Diabetes, Percent by County, CMS 2018










Beneficiaries with High Blood Pressure, Percent by County, CMS 2018







Cancer Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20












Coronary Heart Disease Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20






Homicide Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20







Motor Vehicle Crash Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20







Poisoning Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20











Stroke Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20







Suicide Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20













Obese (BMI >= 30), Adults Age 20+, Percent by County, CDC NCCDPHP 2019





Percentage of Adults Age 18+ with Poor or Fair General Health


